Dear Supporters and Donors,

Thank you so much for the continued support, donations, and thoughtful feedback. We are incredibly grateful for the trust you place in Tele Hope and for the role you play in allowing this work to grow. Thank you as well to the supporters who have invited us into your classrooms, workplaces, and offices.

Our biggest update is that this fall we will be working with all 1,400 incoming freshmen at the University of Wyoming in partnership with Saddle Up. This is a meaningful step forward for us and an opportunity to reach students during a critical transition in their lives. This age group is an ideal focus for our work and where we believe we can be most beneficial for students navigating a unique period of change.

More recently, Green River High School and Tele Hope have built a strong partnership. This will be the first school where we present all four of our workshops throughout the academic year, allowing us to support students in a more intentional and sustained way.

This summer, we will be working with 4H groups across the state of Wyoming. We also had the privilege of working with Leadership Wyoming once again, which continues to be a meaningful and energizing partnership as we slowly expand our age range.

In addition to our work in Oklahoma, Colorado, Arizona, and Wyoming, we are actively expanding into Utah, North Dakota, and potentially Idaho. The demand for this work continues to grow, and we are being thoughtful about expanding in a way that stays true to our mission and values.

We have also begun formally researching our work. Rather than being only research informed, we are becoming research backed. We are measuring loneliness through a self reported scale to ensure our programs are addressing the right problem. Through our partnerships with the university and our own research efforts, we are working to make sure we are truly fighting the right thing. This research will help us better understand our impact, strengthen our credibility, and allow us to compete with national nonprofits while staying grounded in real outcomes and real people.
